## Extract of warranty's general conditions DP-QW410

1) Damage occurring with normal use in accordance to the User's manual and labels on the material will be repaired without charge under the warranty:

## Period of warranty:

**12 months** from DNP PIE invoice date, **or in the limit of the print numbers** detailed below, **whichever comes first**:

	<b>Up to 10 000</b> printed sheets (size 10x15cm - 4x6") <i>Up to 8 000 in case all sheets are printed in Matte, Fine Matte, Luster, or Partial Matte.</i>
• Expendable parts: cutter, DC motor, roller parts, pulley, gears, clutch holder, bearing, filter, etc.	<b>Up to 10 000</b> printed sheets (size 10x15cm - 4x6")
• <b>Printer main unit :</b> Mechanical parts, train wheel, paper course, sensors, Electrical parts, fan.	12 months from DNP PIE invoice date

2) Warranty conditions do not apply under the following circumstances, even if within the warranty period:

- 1. Damage caused by misuse, unauthorized repair, modification, or unforeseeable accidents. Please read carefully the provided User's Manual, and use the device correctly and safely.
- 2. Damage caused by dropping.
- 3. Damage occurring during transportation or due to improper packaging.
- 4. Damage caused by acts of God (fire, earthquake, flooding, lightning, etc.), pollution or extreme voltage.
- 5. Problem caused by connected devices.
- 6. Aesthetic problem that does not affect performance (paint coat, metallic coating parts, plastic deterioration).
- 7. Problems that arise with the passage of time (sound, vibration, grease marks).
- 8. Rust or scratches inside or outside the device.
- 9. Cases of condensation. Condensation is common in places with large temperature fluctuation.
- 10. Foreign objects caught in the printer. This printer was designed to be used indoors, for example, in an office. If setting up the printer outdoors, be sure that proper action is taken to ensure the printer is sealed from foreign matter. If dust or metallic powder get into the printer, it can adversely affect the print quality.
- 11. Use in places with strong vibrations (for example, in vehicles).
- 12. Problems caused by the changing of print parameters.
- 13. Print quality problems resulting from the mixed use of different media in width (for example 10x15 and 11,5x20 sizes) on the same printer.
- 14. Problems caused by the use of unapproved media.
- Pirated goods especially can cause damage. Please avoid using such media.
- 15. Abusive use, as in accelerated testing, such as:
  - Continuous all-black printing. Continuous printing of an image with a black border. - Continuous use in low temperatures.
- 16. Use outside the normal operating environment.
- 17. Storage outside the permitted storage environment.
- 18. When used with USB cable not compatible with USB 2.0 specifications.
