

Extract of warranty's general conditions DT-T6mini

1) Damage occurring with normal use in accordance to the User's manual and labels on the material will be repaired without charge under the warranty:

Period of warranty:

12 months from DNP PIE invoice date.

2) **Warranty conditions do not apply** under the following circumstances, even if within the warranty period:

1. Damage caused by misuse, unauthorized repair, modification, or unforeseeable accidents.
Please read carefully the provided User's Manual, and use the device correctly and safely.
2. Damage caused by dropping.
3. Damage occurring during transportation as a result of improper packaging.
4. Damage caused by acts of God (fire, earthquake, flooding, lightning, etc.), pollution or extreme voltage.
5. Problem caused by connected devices.
6. Aesthetic problem that does not affect performance (sound, vibration, grease marks).
7. Problems that arise with the passage of time (paint coat, metallic coating parts, plastic deterioration).
8. Rust or scratches not on the exterior.
9. Cases of condensation. Condensation is common in places with large temperature fluctuation.
10. Foreign objects caught in the device. This device was designed to be used indoors, for example, in an office. If setting up the device outdoors, be sure that proper action is taken to ensure the device is sealed from foreign matter. If dust or metallic powder get into the device, they can adversely affect its performance.
11. Use in places with strong vibrations (for example, in vehicles).
12. Problems caused by the changing of parameters.
13. Problems caused by the use of unapproved media.
Pirated goods especially can cause damage. Please avoid using such media.
14. Abusive use, as in accelerated testing, such as:
 - Continuous use with no proper shutdown.
 - Continuous use in low temperatures.
15. Use outside the normal operating environment.
16. Storage outside the permitted storage environment.
17. When used with USB cable not compatible with USB 2.0 specifications.
